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#### **Part- A**

**What is the plan of action chalked out by the IQAC in the beginning of the year towards quality enhancement and what is the outcome by the end of the year?**

The objective of the College has been-Achieving Excellence through Innovative Programmes. The Peer Team of the NAAC has taken stock of the working and accredited the College with '**A**' **Grade** in January 2011. IQAC has been formed after that and NAAC office has been informed of the same. The IQAC cell is working efficiently. We have completed various innovative programmes for the year 2011-2012.

**1. (General) is declared on 1<sup>st</sup> June 2011, at.11.00 am. This is the first time above examinations are conducted at the college level, CAP is held in the College and result is declared. The University has brought in 80-20 pattern in which the Term-End examination is given weightage to the extent of 20% for Arts faculty. This is implemented from June 2004 for FYBA.

Advanced Enzyme Sinnar, WIPRO Ltd., Syngenta Ltd., VIP Industries Pvt., Ltd. and Datamaticcs Pvt. Ltd., Lupin, Evolus, IBM GPS, WNS etc, have consented to conduct campus interviews for the academic year 2012-13.
